APPLICATION DEADLINE: **SATURDAY, MARCH 1, 2025**

The scholarship committee will not consider an application received after the deadline.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- A. Applicant must be of 25% Italian ancestry
- B. A graduating high school senior
- C. Attend, or plan to attend a four-year college or university, or junior college
- D. Have a minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- E. Be a resident of North County San Diego (MUST reside north of CA Hwy 56) and have been a resident for a period of not less than 12 consecutive months
- F. Be a citizen of the United States

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION TO INCLUDE, IN ADDITION TO THE ATTACHED:

- 1. Copy of high school transcript
- 2. Minimum of two letters of recommendation (From other than family members)
- 3. Statement attesting to Italian heritage/ancestry signed by a parent or guardian
- 4. Student may be contacted for a personal interview
